We are writing to share with you the changes to the Trust leadership structure that will take place in the Autumn term.

The Alumnis CEO role is currently being advertised nationally and it is anticipated that the successful candidate will start their new role in January 2021. We are very fortunate to have a skilled and experienced Trust leadership team, and in the interim period, members of the existing Trust leadership team will undertake the core statutory functions of the CEO role with the full support of the Board of Directors and the Trust Central Team, until the new CEO is in post.

In September, Mrs. Charlene Marston will be leaving Clawton School following her appointment to a leadership role outside of the Trust. Charlene has had the opportunity to work at Clawton School as Acting Headteacher throughout the duration of her secondment.
